You may be eligible for a cash payment from a class action settlement with SunTrust Bank, now Truist Bank. A lawsuit against SunTrust alleges that certain of its overdraft fees constitute usury, conversion, and money had and received. The case is *Bickerstaff v. SunTrust Bank*, No. 10EV010485, State Court of Fulton County, Georgia.

SunTrust denies any wrongdoing. The parties have agreed to settle the lawsuit to avoid further litigation.

Who Is Included in the Settlement Class?

Every person who had a deposit account with SunTrust Bank that was not closed before June 1, 2010 and who, from July 12, 2006 to April 15, 2014:

- had at least one overdraft of \$500 or less from an ATM or debit card transaction;
- paid any overdraft fees as a result of the transaction;
- and did not receive a refund of those fees;
- and who was a Georgia citizen continuously from July 12, 2010 through October 6, 2017.

Records show you may be a Settlement Class Member.

What Does the Settlement Provide?

The Settlement provides for Settlement Class Members who submit a valid Claim Form to receive payment for a portion of their unrefunded overdraft fees. The Claim Form is not yet available, and the deadline to submit it has not yet been set.

What Are My Options Now?

a. Do Nothing. To stay in the case, you don't need to do anything at this time. If the Settlement is approved, you will be bound by the Settlement, the judgment, and all court orders. If you want to receive a cash payment, you will need to submit a Claim Form later.

b. Opt Out by April 20, 2026. You may request *in writing* to be excluded from the Settlement. The Long Form Notice on the Website explains how to opt out.

c. Object by April 20, 2026. You may object *in writing* to the Settlement. The Long Form Notice on the Website explains how to object.

Fairness Hearing on May 26, 2026. The Court will decide whether to grant final approval of the Settlement, Class Counsel's attorneys' fees and costs, service awards, and objections. You or your lawyer may ask to appear at the hearing, but it is not required. Visit www.SunTrustOverdraftClassAction.com to confirm date and location.

How do I submit a Claim Form? If the Court grants final approval of the Settlement, you will be sent a Claim Form by mail and/or email, which you may submit via mail or online.
